BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

16	(b)	The hourly wage of a tipped employee may be deemed to

3	cents more than the applicable minimum wage.		
4	(c) On September 30, 2016, and on September 30 each year		
5	thereafter, the department of labor and industrial relations		
6	shall calculate an adjusted minimum wage rate to maintain		
7	employee purchasing power by increasing the current year's		
8	minimum wage rate by the rate of inflation. The adjusted		
9	minimum wage rate shall be calculated to the nearest cent using		
10	the consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical		
11	workers, CPI-W, or a successor index, for the twelve months		
12	prior to September 1 of each year as calculated by the United		
13	States Department of Labor. Each adjusted minimum wage rate		
14	calculated under this subsection shall take effect on the		
15	following July 1."		
16	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed

18	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.		
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Report Title: Minimum Wage; Employment

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Description:

Increases minimum wage to \$8.25 starting 07/01/13, \$8.75 starting 07/01/14, and \$9.25 starting 07/01/15 and ending 06/30/16. Authorizes the department of labor and industrial relations to adjust the minimum hourly wage thereafter in accord with the consumer priced index. Effective 07/01/13. (Proposed SD1)

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
