Increases minimum wage to \$8.25 starting 01/01/14, \$8.75 starting 01/01/15, and \$9.25 starting 01/01/16 and ending 12/31/16. Authorizes DLIR to adjust the minimum hourly wage thereafter in accordance with the Honolulu region consumer price index. Effective 7/1/50. (SD2)
