14		protecting rights of confidentiality and privacy.	
15	(d)	The interagency coordinating body shall submit to the	
16	governor	and the legislature, no later than twenty days prior to	
17	the conve	ening of each regular session, a report detailing	
18	activities of the coordinating body and progress on the
