BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 84-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§84-41 Applicability of part. This part applies to
- 4 legislators [, members of the board of education, trustees of the
- 5 office of Hawaiian affairs, the governor, the lieutenant
- 6 governor, and executive department heads and deputies.] and
- 7 employees who are required to file financial disclosure
- 8 statements that are deemed public records pursuant to section
- 9 84-17(d). This part does not apply to any other officer or
- 10 employee of the State."
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 84-43, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
- "(d) The ethics training course shall be held in January
- 14 of each year and at other times as determined by the state
- 15 ethics commission for those who have not attended the course
- 16 previously. [The course shall last at least two hours in
- 17 length.]"
