#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BANYAN DRIVE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Pursuant to section 264-2, Hawaii Revised
- 2 Statutes, by executive order the governor is authorized to turn
- 3 over in fee simple banyan drive located in Hilo to the county of
- 4 Hawaii.
- 5 SECTION 2. Upon execution of an executive order by the
- 6 governor, the jurisdiction, functions, powers, duties, and
- 7 authority heretofore exercised by the state department of
- 8 transportation relating to banyan drive located in the county of
- 9 Hawaii shall be transferred to and conferred to the county of
- 10 Hawaii by this Act.
- 11 The county of Hawaii shall succeed to all of the rights and
- 12 powers previously exercised, and all the duties and obligations
- 13 incurred by the state department of transportation in the
- 14 exercise of the functions, powers, duties, and authority
- 15 transferred, whether such functions, powers, duties, and
- 16 authority are mentioned in or granted by law, contract, or other
- 17 document.

- 1 SECTION 3. For purposes of this Act, specific provisions
- 2 relating to state highway functions under chapter 264, Hawaii
- 3 Revised Statutes, that apply to banyan drive shall be deemed to
- 4 apply to the county of Hawaii.
- 5 SECTION 4. Concurrent with the transfer of jurisdiction
- 6 over banyan drive to the county of Hawaii, all rights, powers,
- 7 functions, and duties of the state department of transportation
- 8 with respect to banyan drive shall be transferred to the county
- 9 of Hawaii.
- 10 SECTION 5. Concurrent with the transfer of jurisdiction
- 11 over banyan drive to the county of Hawaii, all appropriations,
- 12 records, equipment, machines, files, supplies, contracts, books,
- 13 papers, documents, maps, and other personal property heretofore
- 14 made, used, acquired, or held by the state department of
- 15 transportation relating to the functions transferred to the
- 16 county of Hawaii shall be transferred with the functions to
- 17 which they relate.
- 18 SECTION 6. (a) Concurrent with the transfer of
- 19 jurisdiction over banyan drive to the county of Hawaii, the
- 20 state director of transportation shall transfer to the county of
- 21 Hawaii all federal aid to the State that is to be used for
- 22 highway maintenance, operation, repair, construction, or other



- 1 uses on banyan drive. The state department of transportation
- 2 shall do all things necessary to ensure that federal aid to the
- 3 State is transferred to Hawaii county as appropriate for the use
- 4 by the county of Hawaii for state highways transferred to the
- 5 county of Hawaii under this Act, and that no federal funds are
- 6 lost or jeopardized for this use.
- 7 (b) It is the intent of this Act not to jeopardize the
- 8 receipt of any federal aid nor to impair the obligation of the
- 9 State or the county of Hawaii, or any agency respectively
- 10 thereof, to the holders of any bond issued by the State or by
- 11 any such agency, and to the extent, and only to the extent,
- 12 necessary to effectuate this intent, the governor or mayor of
- 13 the county of Hawaii, as applicable, may modify the strict
- 14 provisions of this Act, but shall promptly report any such
- 15 modification with reasons therefore to the legislature at its
- 16 next session thereafter for review by the legislature.
- 17 SECTION 7. Article VIII, section 5, of the Hawaii State
- 18 Constitution, relating to state funding of mandated programs to
- 19 the counties, shall be deemed satisfied by the transfer of state
- 20 appropriations and federal funds from the State to the county of
- 21 Hawaii under this Act; provided that the county of Hawaii may

- 1 request the legislature to appropriate additional funds as
- 2 necessary from time to time to implement this Act.
- 3 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2014.
