A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MAUNA KEA STATE RECREATIONAL AREA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The State shall transfer in fee simple Mauna
- 2 Kea state recreational area to the county of Hawaii.
- 3 For purposes of this Act, the legislature finds that
- 4 section 171-64.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, does not apply. That
- 5 section requires the department of land and natural resources to
- 6 submit a concurrent resolution to the legislature for review of
- 7 a sale or gift of land that it proposes. The transfer of Mauna
- 8 Kea state recreation area to the county of Hawaii is not
- 9 proposed by the department of land and natural resources;
- 10 rather, this Act is a mandate imposed by the legislature upon
- 11 the department.
- 12 SECTION 2. The jurisdiction, functions, powers, duties,
- 13 and authority heretofore exercised by the department of land and
- 14 natural resources relating to Mauna Kea state recreational area
- 15 located in the county of Hawaii shall be transferred to and
- 16 conferred to the county of Hawaii by this Act.
- 17 The county of Hawaii shall succeed to all of the rights and
- 18 powers previously exercised, and all the duties and obligations

- 1 incurred by the department of land and natural resources in the
- 2 exercise of the functions, powers, duties, and authority
- 3 transferred, whether such functions, powers, duties, and
- 4 authority are mentioned in or granted by law, contract, or other
- 5 documents.
- 6 SECTION 3. For purposes of this Act, specific provisions
- 7 relating to public lands under chapter 171, Hawaii Revised
- 8 Statutes, that apply to Mauna Kea state recreational area shall
- 9 be deemed to apply to the county of Hawaii.
- 10 SECTION 4. Concurrent with the transfer of jurisdiction
- 11 over Mauna Kea state recreational area to the county of Hawaii,
- 12 all rights, powers, functions, liabilities, claims, and duties
- 13 of the department of land and natural resources with respect to
- 14 Mauna Kea state recreational area shall be transferred to the
- 15 county of Hawaii.
- 16 SECTION 5. Concurrent with the transfer of jurisdiction of
- 17 Mauna Kea state recreational area to the county of Hawaii, all
- 18 appropriations, records, equipment, machines, files, supplies,
- 19 contracts, books, papers, documents, maps, and other personal
- 20 property heretofore made, used, acquired, or held by the
- 21 department of land and natural resources relating to the

- 1 functions transferred to the county of Hawaii shall be
- 2 transferred with the functions to which they relate.
- 3 SECTION 6. (a) Concurrent with the transfer of
- 4 jurisdiction of Mauna Kea state recreational area to the county
- 5 of Hawaii, the department of land and natural resources shall
- 6 transfer to the county of Hawaii all state appropriations that
- 7 are used for maintenance, operation, repair, construction, or
- 8 other uses in Mauna Kea state recreational area.
- 9 (b) It is the intent of this Act not to jeopardize the
- 10 receipt of any federal aid nor to impair the obligation of the
- 11 State or the county of Hawaii, or any agency respectively
- 12 thereof, to the holders of any bond issued by the State or by
- 13 any such agency, and to the extent, and only to the extent,
- 14 necessary to effectuate this intent, the governor or mayor of
- 15 the county of Hawaii, as applicable, may modify the strict
- 16 provisions of this Act, but shall promptly report any such
- 17 modification with reasons therefore to the legislature at its
- 18 next session thereafter for review by the legislature.
- 19 SECTION 7. Article VIII, section 5, of the Hawaii State
- 20 Constitution, relating to state funding of mandated programs to
- 21 the counties, shall be deemed satisfied by the transfer of state
- 22 appropriations and federal funds from the State to the county of



- Hawaii under this Act; provided that the county of Hawaii may 1
- request the legislature to appropriate additional funds as 2
- necessary from time to time to implement this Act. 3
- SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2014.
