## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 27, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 3 read as follows: 4 Acceptance of copies of documents permissible. Notwithstanding any law or rule to the contrary, the State shall 5 6 not require any person to file the original of any document for 7 any purpose if a duplicate copy of the original is available for 8 filing." 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 10 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to 11 read as follows: 12 "\$46- Acceptance of copies of documents permissible. Notwithstanding any law or rule to the contrary, a county shall
- 13 14 not require any person to file the original of any document for 15 any purpose if a duplicate copy of the original is available for 16 filing."

- 2 date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
