2	the time period under state law shall prevail."
3	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
4	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
5	begun before its effective date.
6	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Administrative Procedures; Time Period to Review Applications for County Permits

Description:

Requires state agencies to comply with county rules to grant or deny permit applications for development-related permits within a specified time as contained in county rule; provided that if a county agency has not adopted such a rule and a state law specifies a maximum time period for granting or denying a state permit, the time period under state law shall prevail.
