# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

**18** 

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to authorize a state
income tax credit for certain expenses paid or incurred by
school teachers in connection with supplementary materials used
by teachers in the classroom.
SECTION 2. Chapter 235, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
and to read as follows:
"§235- Certain expenses of school teachers; tax credit.
(a) There shall be allowed to each qualified taxpayer subject
to the tax imposed by this chapter a tax credit for certain
expenses of school teachers that shall be deductible from the
taxpayer's net income tax liability, if any, imposed by this
chapter for the taxable year in which the credit is properly
claimed.
(b) For purposes of this section:
"Certain expenses" means expenses paid or incurred by a
qualifying taxpayer who incurs the expenses in connection with

books, supplies (other than athletic supplies for courses of

    (including related software and services) and supplementary
    materials used by the qualifying taxpayer in the classroom.

         "Qualifying taxpayer" means a school teacher, special

    education teacher, school librarian, or counselor employed by

    the department of education, a charter school, or a private

    school in the State that instructs students between junior

    kindergarten and twelfth grade.

         (c) The amount of the tax credit shall be equal to a

    maximum of $ for certain expenses in any taxable year.

         (d) If the tax credit under this section exceeds the
12
    taxpayer's net income tax liability, the excess of credit over
13
    liability may be used as a tax credit against the taxpayer's net
14
    income tax liability in subsequent years until exhausted. All
15
    claims for a tax credit under this section, including amended
    claims, shall be filed on or before the end of the twelfth month
16

    following the close of the taxable year for which the tax credit
18
    may be claimed. Failure to comply with the foregoing provision

    shall constitute a waiver of the right to claim the tax credit.

         (e) No other tax credit may be claimed under this chapter

    for the certain expenses used to properly claim a tax credit

    under this section for the taxable year.

8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050, and

shall apply to taxable years beginning after December 31, 2012.
