BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-2153, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$304A-2153[+] University of Hawaii tuition and fees
- 4 special fund. (a) There is established the University of
- 5 Hawaii tuition and fees special fund into which shall be
- 6 deposited all revenue collected by the university for regular,

- 8 course and fee charges, and any other charges to students,
- 9 except as provided by law. Moneys deposited into the fund shall
- 10 be expended to maintain or improve the university's programs and
- 11 operations [and]. At least ninety per cent of the moneys
- 12 deposited into the fund shall be expended solely for student
- 13 education programs, and no more than ten per cent of the moneys
- 14 deposited in the fund may be expended for administrative costs
