# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 304A-2153, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) There is established the University of Hawaii tuition 4 and fees special fund into which shall be deposited all revenue 5 collected by the university for regular, summer, and continuing education credit tuition, tuition-related course and fee 6 7 charges, and any other charges to students, except as provided 8 by law. Moneys deposited into the fund shall be expended to maintain or improve the university's programs and operations 9 10 [and]. Moneys deposited into to the fund shall not be: 11 (1) Expended on administrative salaries at the university; 12  $\left[\frac{1}{2}\right]$  (2) Used as a justification for reducing any budget 13 request or allotment to the university unless the university requests such a reduction; 14 15 Transferred unless otherwise authorized by the [-(2)] (3) 16 legislature; and 17  $\left[\frac{3}{3}\right]$  (4) Restricted by the governor or the director of 18 finance without the prior approval of the legislature.
