BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 571-46.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

3 "§571-46.3 Grandparents' visitation rights; petition; 4 **notice**; order. (a) A grandparent or the grandparents of a 5 minor child may file a petition with the court for an order of 6 reasonable visitation rights. The court may award reasonable visitation rights; provided that the following criteria are met: 7 This State is the home state of the child at the time 8 (1)9 of the commencement of the proceeding; and [Reasonable] Denial of reasonable visitation rights 10 (2) [are in the best interests of] would cause significant 11 demonstrable harm to the child. 12 13 In ruling on the petition, the court shall consider (b) 14 factors, including the following: The nature and extent of any pre-existing relationship 15 (1)
