#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTI	ON 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

4	" <u>§302</u>	(a) Beginning January 1, 2014, beverages other	
5	than water	, milk, or one hundred per cent fruit juices shall not	
6	be sold to a pupil at an elementary school.		
7	(b)	An elementary school may permit the sale of beverages	
8	that do not comply with subsection (a) as part of a school		
9	fundraising event in any of the following circumstances:		
10	(1)	The items are sold by pupils of the school and the	
11		sale of those items takes place off the premises of	
12		the school; and	
13	(2)	The items are sold by pupils of the school and the	
14		sale of those items takes place one-half hour or more	
15		after the end of the schoolday.	
16	(c)	Beginning January 1, 2014, from one-half hour before	
17	the start	of the schoolday to one-half hour after the end of the

1	schoolday	, only the following beverages may be sold to a pupil
2	at a midd	le or intermediate school:
3	(1)	Drinks that are one hundred per cent fruit juice;
4	(2)	Drinking water; and
5	(3)	Milk, including but not limited to chocolate milk, soy
6		milk, rice milk, and other similar dairy or nondairy
7		milk.
8	(d)	A middle or intermediate school may permit the sale of
9	beverages	that do not comply with subsection (c) as part of a
10	school event if the sale of those items are sold by pupils of

12	(1)	Off the premises of the school; and
13	(2)	One-half hour or more after the end of the schoolday.
14	(e)	This section does not prohibit an elementary, middle,

18	beverages	shall be sold in any vending machine on school
