A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaii health
- 2 connector is the online health insurance exchange for Hawaii.
- 3 In August 2012, the Hawaii health connector received a grant
- 4 from the United States Department of Health and Human Services.
- 5 This grant will enable the connector to meet several new federal
- 6 milestones. In November 2012, the connector announced it
- 7 submitted its blueprint application, one of the requirements for
- 8 full implementation of the federal Patient Protection and
- 9 Affordable Care Act, to the United States Department of Health
- 10 and Human Services two weeks ahead of the original deadline.
- 11 The legislature further finds that the Hawaii health
- 12 connector has been working as quickly as possible to meet
- 13 federal milestones, get fully staffed, and maintain frequent
- 14 communication with community stakeholders, all in preparation
- 15 for the launch of the online health insurance marketplace in
- 16 January 2014.
- 17 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support
- 18 the continued operations of the Hawaii health connector.
