## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State faces a
- 2 severe shortage of healthcare providers. This situation is
- 3 particularly acute in primary care, where most of the
- 4 prevention, early intervention, and cost savings in healthcare
- 5 occur.
- 6 The legislature further finds that the Hawaii health
- 7 systems corporation primary care training program is an
- 8 effective way to reduce the impact of the shortage of primary
- 9 care providers and improve access to healthcare throughout the
- 10 State. Administered by Hilo medical center in coordination with
- 11 Hawaii health systems corporation regions, this
- 12 interdisciplinary program includes the Hawaii island family
- 13 medicine residency program and training for advanced practice
- 14 nurses from the school of nursing and dental hygiene at the
- 15 University of Hawaii at Manoa and the school of nursing at the
- 16 University of Hawaii at Hilo; clinical pharmacists from the
- 17 University of Hawaii at Hilo's college of pharmacy; and post-

- 1 doctoral fellows from I Ola Lahui, an organization that trains
- 2 psychologists to meet the needs of those living in rural areas.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to address the shortage of
- 4 primary care providers in the State by appropriating funds for
- 5 the Hawaii health systems corporation primary care training
- 6 program at the Hilo medical center which will be expanded to
- 7 include neighbor island health facilities. The success of this
- 8 program's training model will generate interdisciplinary teams
- 9 that are capable of caring for four times as many patients as
- 10 independent practicing physicians. Hawaii will benefit greatly
- 11 because this program helps to eliminate the need to train or
- 12 attract unrealistically high numbers of physicians.
- 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and
- 16 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 17 year 2014-2015 for the Hawaii health systems corporation primary
- 18 care training program at the Hilo medical center.
- 19 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 20 health systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
