### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE INTERNET PRIVACY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII: 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 481B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 3 to read as follows: 4 INTERNET PRIVACY REQUIREMENTS "PART 5 §481B-A Definitions. For the purposes of this part, the 6 following definitions shall apply: 7 "Conspicuously post" means to post a privacy policy using any of the following methods: 9 A webpage upon which the actual privacy policy is (1)10 posted if the webpage is the homepage or first 11 significant page after entering the website; 12 (2) An icon that hyperlinks to a webpage on which the

actual privacy policy is posted, if the icon is located on the homepage or the first significant page after entering the website and if the icon contains the word "privacy". The icon shall also use a color that contrasts with the background color of the webpage or is otherwise distinguishable;

The term "operator" shall not include any 3 third party that operates, hosts, or manages, but does not own, 4 a website or online service on the owner's behalf or by 5 processing information on behalf of the owner. 6 "Personally identifiable information" means individually 7 8 identifiable information about an individual consumer collected online by the operator from that individual and maintained by 9 the operator in an accessible form, including any of the 10 11 following: (1) A first and last name; 12 (2) A home or other physical address, including street 13 name and name of a city or town; 14 15 (3) An e-mail address; (4) A telephone number; 16 (5) A social security number; 17 Any other identifier that permits the physical or (6) 18 online contacting of a specific individual; or 19 20 Information concerning a user that the website or (7)

online service collects online from the user and

9	(4)	Identify the effective date of the operator's privacy	
10		policy.	
11	§ <b>481</b>	B-C Violation. An operator shall not be deemed in	
12	violation	of this part unless the operator fails to post its	
13	policy wi	thin thirty days after being notified of noncompliance.	
14	An operator who violates this part shall be guilty of a		
15	violation under section 480-2."		
16	SECTION 2. In codifying the new sections added by section		
17	1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute		
18	appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating		
19	the new sections in this Act.		
20	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
