A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CORRECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 353, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§353- Committed persons; sale of products and crafts.
5	(a) The department shall permit committed persons, at the
6	director's discretion, to create products and crafts for sale
7	including photographs, paintings, drawings, sewn items,
8	crocheted items, woodwork, and other items deemed sellable by
9	the director.
10	(b) Products and crafts may be sold by the director at a
11	location deemed appropriate by the director, including
12	electronic website postings or in stores.
13	(c) Of the proceeds from the sale of products and crafts:
14	(1) Twenty-five per cent shall be deposited into the
15	committed person's current facility's fund for re-
16	entry or rehabilitation services or programs;



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1	(2)	Twenty-five per cent shall be deposited into the crime	
2		victim compensation special fund established by	
3		section 351-62.5; and	
4	(3)	Fifty per cent shall be deposited into an account of	
5		the committed person established pursuant to section	
6		<u>353-20.</u> "	
7	SECT	ION 2. Section 351-62.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
8	amended b	y amending subsection (d) to read as follows:	
9	"(d)	Funds received pursuant to section 354D-12(b)(1) and	
10	amounts r	eceived pursuant to sections 351-35, 351-62.6, 351-63,	
11	<u>353- ,</u> 7	06-605, and 853-1 shall be deposited into the crime	
12	victim co	mpensation special fund. Moneys received shall be used	
13	for compe	nsation payments, operating expenses, salaries of	
14	positions	as authorized by the legislature, and collection of	
15	fees. Th	e commission may enter into memorandums of agreement	
16	with the	judiciary for the collection of fees by the judiciary;	
17	provided that no funds shall be deposited by the judiciary into		
18	the crime	victim compensation special fund until collected."	
19	SECT	ION 3. The department of public safety shall conduct a	
20	study to	ascertain the practices of correctional facilities in	
21	other sta	tes with regard to the making and sale of arts and	
22	crafts by	inmates. The study shall include information on the	



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means by which the items are sold, the price of the articles,
and the allocation of proceeds from sales.

3 The department of public safety shall report its findings 4 and recommendations to the legislature no later than twenty days 5 prior to the convening of the regular session of 2014.

6 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.

Corrections; Committed Persons; Sale of Crafts

Description:

Allows committed persons to create and place for sale approved products and crafts. Allocates proceeds to rehabilitation programs, the crime victim compensation special fund, and the committed person's account. Requires department of public safety to study other states' practices on the making and sale of arts and crafts by inmates. Requires a report to the 2014 legislature.
