1	SECTION 1. Section 710-1016.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"[$+$]§710-1016.6[$+$] Impersonating a law enforcement officer
4	in the first degree. (1) A person commits the offense of
5	impersonating a law enforcement officer in the first degree if,
6	with intent to deceive, the person pretends to be a law
7	enforcement officer, and [is armed with a firearm.]:
8	(a) is armed with a firearm;
9	(b) intentionally or knowingly causes another person to
10	apprehend a harmful or offensive contact;
11	(c) threatens violence to another person by an immediate
12	show of force;
13	(d) threatens or attempts to confiscate or damage property
14	of another person; or,
15	(e) threatens or attempts to exercise dominion or control
16	over another person.

degree is a class C felony."
