BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 312-2.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§312-2.1 Appointment of state librarian; duties; salary.
- 4 (a) The state librarian shall be appointed by the [board of
- 5 education] governor and with the advice and consent of the
- 6 senate, without regard to chapter 76, shall be under the
- 7 direction of the [board] governor, shall be responsible for the
- 8 operation, planning, programming, and budgeting of all
- 9 community/school and public libraries within the State, and may
- 10 be removed by a majority vote of [its members] the legislature.
- 11 The state librarian may be appointed:
- 12 (1) Without regard to the state residency provisions of
- 13 section 78-1(b); and
- 14 (2) For a term of up to four years.
- (b) The salary of the state librarian shall be set by the
- 16 [board of education] legislature at a rate no greater than
- 17 \$120,000 a year.



- 1 (c) The state librarian may appoint, without regard to
- 2 chapter 76, one secretary for the state librarian. The
- 3 secretary for the state librarian shall serve at the pleasure of
- 4 the state librarian."
- 5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
