A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$130,000 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the 4 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 5 2014-2015 to fund the Honolulu zero to three court program for: 6 (1) The coordinator's transportation to visit children and 7 parents; 8 (2)Emergency housing assistance; 9 A secure opening at a residential drug and alcohol (3) 10 facility that will accommodate a mother and child; 11 (4) Development and implementation of an incentive program 12 similar to the successful model utilized in family 13 drug court; 14 (5) Training and professional development of zero to three 15 court team members and community partners; and 16 Creation and utilization of an enhanced visitation and (6) 17 parenting coaching site in leeward Oahu.





- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the judiciary
 for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
