A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public disclosure of
- 2 incomes of state employees and legislators enhances public trust
- 3 because the disclosure tends to reduce real and perceived
- 4 conflicts of interest.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to require a state employee or
- 6 legislator to disclose every source of annual income that totals
- 7 more than the employee's or legislator's annual salary if that
- 8 source is a registered lobbyist or lobbying organization.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 10 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 "§84- Additional requirements of disclosure.
- 13 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, and in addition
- 14 to the requirements of section 84-17, an employee or legislator
- 15 shall disclose every source of annual income that totals more
- 16 than the employee's or legislator's annual salary if that source
- 17 is a registered lobbyist or lobbying organization."

- 1 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 2 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2113.
