- 10 same] a comparable claim or by the agreement of the parties to
- 11 the arbitration proceeding."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
