A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WITNESSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the per diem stipend

amount for out-of-state witnesses has remained unchanged for a

3 number of years. This amount is no longer sufficient to pay the

4 personal expenses of out-of-state witnesses, such as for lodging

5 and food. Often, these individuals are forced to take money out

6 of their own pockets to cover necessary personal expenses when

subpoenaed to return to the State as a witness in state court

9 Because the per diem stipend amount has not been adjusted

to keep pace with the cost of living in Hawaii, it has emerged

11 as an economic "barrier" that either discourages or prevents an

12 out-of-state witness from pursuing charges against offenders due

to economic considerations. Further, the legislature also finds

14 that the per diem stipend amount for witnesses that are required

15 to travel to a different island is also insufficient to cover

16 the witness' personal expenses when that witness is required to

17 stay overnight.

1	The purpose of this Act is to increase the amount of per
2	diem stipends for out-of-state witnesses as well as make
3	available additional amounts of per diem stipends for a witness
4	who must travel to another island, if that witness is required
5	to stay overnight.
6	SECTION 2. Section 621-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
8	"(a) Every witness legally required to attend a state
9	court or grand jury in any criminal case, other than a public
10	officer or employee, shall be entitled to \$20 for each day's
11	attendance and a reasonable mileage fee to be established
12	pursuant to rules adopted by the judiciary for each mile
13	actually and necessarily traveled on the ground each way,
14	including travel to and from the nearest airport when required
15	to travel from another island or from outside the State.
16	In addition to witness' fees, every witness[, who]:
17	(1) Who attends a state court from outside the State shall
18	be entitled to the actual round-trip cost of plane
19	travel, plus [$\frac{$110}{}$] $\frac{$145}{}$ per twenty-four-hour day[${7}$];

1	shall be entitled to the actual round-trip cost of
2	plane travel, plus \$55 per twenty-four-hour day[$ au$
3	which amounts]; provided that when the witness is
4	required to stay overnight, the witness shall be
5	entitled to an additional \$90 per twenty-four-hour
6	day.
7	These per diem payments shall cover all personal expenses, such
8	as board and lodging[. These per diem payments] and shall be
9	computed on the basis of quarter day periods of time."
10	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.

Witnesses in Criminal Cases; Per Diem Payments

Description:

Increases the per diem payments for out-of-state witnesses in criminal cases. Provides an additional per diem payment for witnesses from any island other than the island on which the court is located, when that witness is required to stay overnight. Effective July 1, 2030. (SB879 HD2)
