A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SENTENCE OF IMPRISONMENT FOR SEXUAL ASSAULT OF A MINOR UNDER THE AGE OF TWELVE YEARS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$706- Sentence of imprisonment for sexual assault of a
- 5 minor under the age of twelve years. (1) Any person who is
- 6 convicted of an offense under section 707-730(1)(a), 707-
- 7 730(1)(d), or 707-730(1)(e) against a minor under the age of
- 8 twelve years, if not sentenced to an extended term of
- 9 imprisonment pursuant to 706-662, shall be sentenced to a
- 10 mandatory minimum term of imprisonment of six years, eight
- 11 months without the possibility of parole or probation.
- 12 (2) Any person who is convicted of an offense under
- 13 section 707-731 against a minor under the age of twelve years,
- 14 if not sentenced to an extended term of imprisonment pursuant to
- 15 706-662, shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum term of
- 16 imprisonment of three years, four months without the possibility
- 17 of parole or probation.



1	(3) Any person who is convicted of an offense under
2	section 707-732(1)(a) against a minor under the age of twelve
3	years, if not sentenced to an extended term of imprisonment
4	pursuant to 706-662, shall be sentenced to a mandatory minimum
5	term of imprisonment of one year, eight months without the
6	possibility of parole or probation."
7	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
8	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
9	begun before its effective date.
10	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
