BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "S291- Electronic citation surcharge. (a) In addition
- 5 to any other civil penalties ordered by the court, a person who
- 6 violates any provision under this part shall be ordered to pay
- 7 an electronic citation surcharge of \$5 unless the county in
- 8 which the citation was issued has, by ordinance, elected not to
- 9 be subject to this part.
- 10 (b) The person shall pay the surcharge to the clerk of the
- 11 court. The surcharge shall be deposited with the director of
- 12 finance who shall credit the surcharge to the electronic
- 13 citation special fund established under section 291C-C."
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
- 16 to read as follows:
