3 SECTION 14. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act 4 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2014, and 5 June 30, 2015, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of 6 those dates.

7 SECTION 15. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
