A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The legislature finds that housing first
2	programs	are a collaborative effort between the department of
3	human ser	vices and the United States Department of Housing and
4	Urban Development that provides housing and support services for	
5	chronically homeless individuals, including those who have an	
6	addiction or mental illness, or both. The principles of housing	
7	first programs include:	
8	(1)	Moving chronically homeless individuals into housing
9		directly from streets and the shelters without a
10		precondition of accepting or complying with treatment;
11	(2)	Providing robust support services for program
12		participants that are predicated on assertive
13		engagement rather than coercion;
14	(3)	Granting chronically homeless individuals priority as
15		program participants in housing first programs;
16	(4)	Embracing a harm-reduction approach to addictions
17		rather than mandating abstinence while supporting
18		program participant commitments to recovery; and

1 (5) Providing program participants with leases and tenant 2 protections as provided by law. 3 The housing first programs in the State closely resemble 4 the requirements of the United States Housing and Urban 5 Development shelter plus care program and the Veterans 6 Administration veteran's assisted supportive housing voucher 7 program for homeless veterans. In its December 2011 report to 8 the legislature pursuant to section 346-378, Hawaii Revised 9 Statutes, the department of human services reported that the 10 State has six hundred fifty-eight permanent housing placements 11 plus support services through the shelter plus care and 12 veteran's assisted supportive housing voucher programs. 13 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 14 department of human services to support the State's housing 15 first programs in assisting Hawaii's chronically homeless who are often the most vulnerable, most visible, and most difficult 16 17 to serve. 18 There is appropriated out of the general SECTION 2. 19 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,000,000 or so much 20 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the 21 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 22 2014-2015 to be deposited to the credit of the housing first

- 2 the department of human services to continue to administer
- 3 housing first programs for chronically homeless individuals in
- 4 the State.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 5
- 6 of human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
