1	SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended		
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to		
3	read as follows:		
4	"§46- Coastal waters aquarium fish; regulatory		
5	jurisdiction. Beginning January 1, 2014, each county shall		
6	regulate aquarium fish found in each respective county's coastal		
7	waters, including prohibiting any taking, establishing limits on		
8	taking, and otherwise managing aquarium fish populations found		
9	in its respective coastal waters.		
10	For purposes of this section, "coastal waters" means all		
11	waters surrounding the coast of an island in this State to a		
12	point three miles seaward from the coast."		
13	SECTION 2. Section 187A-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
14	amended by amending the definition of "aquatic life" to read as		
15	follows:		
16	""Aquatic life" means any type or species of mammal,		
17	fish[7] other than aquarium fish found in coastal waters as

1 crustacean, arthropod, invertebrate, coral, or other animal that 2 inhabits the freshwater or marine environment and includes any 3 part, product, egg, or offspring thereof; or freshwater or 4 marine plants, including seeds, roots, products, and other parts 5 thereof." 6 SECTION 3. Section 188-22.9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 7 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 8 "(b) In addition to the provisions of this chapter, the 9 following uses or activities shall be regulated in the Ha'ena 10 community-based subsistence fishing area: 11 (1) Any activities with a commercial purpose, as defined in section 187A-1; 12 13 (2) The issuance of any commercial marine license, as 14 defined in section 187A-1; 15 (3) The issuance of any aquarium fish permits, pursuant to 16 section 188-31[+] other than for aquarium fish found 17 in coastal waters as defined in section 46- ; 18 (4)Fishing with the use of gill nets; 19 (5) Fishing with self-contained underwater breathing 20 apparatus and spears; and 21 (6) Any other use or activity that the department of land 22 and natural resources, in consultation with the

1 inhabitants of the ahupua'a of Ha'ena and other interested parties, deems appropriate." 2 SECTION 4. Section 188-31, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 3 amended as follows: 4 5 1. By amending subsection (a) to read: 6 "(a) Except as prohibited by law, the department, upon 7 receipt of a written application, may issue, other than for 8 aquarium fish found in coastal waters as defined in section 9 46- , an aquarium fish permit, not longer than one year in 10 duration, to use fine meshed traps, or fine meshed nets other 11 than throw nets, for the taking of marine or freshwater nongame 12 fish and other aquatic life for aquarium purposes." 13 2. By amending subsections (c) and (d) to read: 14 "(c) [It] Notwithstanding aquarium fish found in coastal waters as defined in section 46- , it shall be illegal to sell 15 16 or offer for sale any fish and other aquatic life taken under an 17 aquarium fish permit unless those fish and other aquatic life 18 are sold alive for aquarium purposes. 19 The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 for 20 the purpose of this section.

3	SECTION 6. Section 188F-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

7	fishery management area plan that identifies and designates					
8	appropriate areas of the management area as follows:					
9	[-(1) Designates a minimum of thirty per cent of coastal					
10	waters in the West Hawaii regional fishery management					
11	area as fish replenishment areas in which aquarium					
12	fish collection is prohibited;					
13	(2) (1) Establishes a day-use mooring buoy system along

16	where no anchoring is allowed;
