(4)One member representing the department of public 1 2 safety; One member representing the department of the attorney 3 (5) 4 general; One member representing the mental health community; (6) 5 One member representing the National Alliance on 6 (7) 7 Mental Illness: 8 (8) One member representing the National Rifle 9 Association; 10 (9) One member representing the Hawaii Rifle Association; One member representing the Hawaii Psychiatric Medical 11 (10)Association; 12 One member representing the Hawaii Psychological 13 (11) Association; and 14 One member who owns a gun shop. 15 (12) 16 (c) The task force shall submit a written report of findings and recommendations, including any proposed 17 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior 18 19 to the convening of the regular session of 2015. 20 The task force shall terminate on June 30, 2015. (d)
