A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII COUNTY YOUTH PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2	revenues o	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$570,000 or so much
3	thereof as	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2013-2014 and the
4	same sum o	or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
5	2014-2015	for grants-in-aid to the county of Hawaii for the
6	provision	of various youth programs, as follows:
7	(1)	\$100,000: Victory gardens for youth in North
8		Hilo/Hamakua;
9	(2)	\$200,000: Perpetuation of Hawaiian cultural, or other
10		similar, programs for two hundred youth island wide,
11		including Ka Hana No'eau (located in the rural North
12		Kohala district of Hawaii island, this project has
13		developed innovative mentoring programs for Hawaiian
14		youth that meld traditional knowledge with
15		<pre>contemporary technologies);</pre>
16	(3)	\$25,000: Agape camp for fifty children of
17		incarcerated parents;

1	(4)	\$95,000: Lanakila learning center for at risk youth
2		from Hilo high school; and
3	(5)	\$150,000: Five grants for underage drinking
4		prevention community grants.
5	SECT	ION 2. The sums appropriated in section 1 of this Act
6	shall be	expended by the following departments:
7	(1)	Item (1) by the University of Hawaii at Hilo, college
8		of tropical agriculture and human resources, extension
9		services;
10	(2)	Item (2) by the Office of Hawaiian Affairs; and
11	(3)	Items (3), (4), and (5) by the department of public
12		safety.
13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
