A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHARTER SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that article X, section
- 2 1, of the Hawaii State Constitution states, in relevant part,
- 3 that "[t]he State shall provide for the establishment, support
- 4 and control of a statewide system of public schools . . .
- 5 including physical facilities therefor." The legislature
- 6 further finds that this provision of the Hawaii State
- 7 Constitution imposes an obligation on the State to provide
- 8 funding for public charter school facilities.
- 9 Department of education schools that convert to charter
- 10 schools have pre-existing facilities and remain on the
- 11 department of education's regular repair and maintenance and
- 12 capital improvement schedules.
- Hawaii 3R's, a Hawaii nonprofit organization, brings
- 14 outside financing and human resources together to tackle the
- 15 repair and maintenance backlog in Hawaii's public schools.
- 16 Currently, all of Hawaii 3R's public school repair and
- 17 maintenance projects must be selected from the department of
- accounting and general services' unfunded repair and maintenance
