# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LEGISLATIVE PROCEDURES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and to read
3	as follows:
4	"PART . HEARINGS ON REPORTS
5	§21- Procedures for consideration of reports. (a)
6	Reports to the legislature of studies and audits conducted by:
7	(1) The executive departments and agencies, including the
8	Hawaii health systems corporation;
9	(2) The auditor;
10	(3) The judiciary;
11	(4) The legislative reference bureau; or
12	(5) The office of Hawaiian affairs,
13	that are requested by a concurrent resolution adopted by the
14	legislature or required by law, including budget measures, shall
15	be submitted, at a minimum, to the clerk of each house, to the
16	president of the senate and speaker of the house of
17	representatives, the chair of the applicable subject matter
18	committee of each chamber, and the legislative reference bureau

- 3 (b) The respective chairs of the committees to whom a

- 1 SECTION 3. Sections 21-1, 21-2, 21-6, 21-13, 21-15, and
- 2 21-19, Hawaii Revised Statutes, are amended by substituting the
- 3 word "part" wherever the word "chapter" appears, as the context

### Report Title:

Legislative Hearings; Studies and Reports

#### Description:

Requires any report of a study or an audit made by an executive department or agency, including the Hawaii health systems corporation, and by the legislative reference bureau, auditor, judiciary, or office of Hawaiian affairs, to be submitted to the clerk of each house, senate president, speaker of the house, chairs of the appropriate subject matter committee of each house, and the legislative reference bureau library. Requires a public hearing or informational briefing, except if waived by the senate president or speaker of the house of representatives. Excludes certain routine reports.
