A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT VEHICLE USE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to limit the use of 1 2 government vehicles for personal reasons. Section 105-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 3 SECTION 2. amended to read as follows: 4 "§105-2 Exceptions. Section 105-1 shall not apply to: 5 6 [(1) The governor; 7 (2) The mayor of any county; (3) Any member of a police department or a fire department 8 or of the staff of a hospital, or any officer or 9 10 employee of the board of water supply of the city and county of Honolulu, when using a motor vehicle for a 11 personal purpose incidental to the person's service or 12 work (but not for pleasure); 13 (4) Any officer or employee of the State who, upon written 14 recommendation of the comptroller, is given written 15 permission by the governor to use, operate, or drive 16 17 for personal use (but not for pleasure) any motor vehicle owned or controlled by the State; 18

1	(5)	Any officer or employee of any county who, upon
2		written recommendation of the budget director, is
3		given written permission by the mayor, to use, operate
4		or drive for personal use (but not for pleasure) any
5		motor vehicle owned or controlled by the county;
6	(6)]	(1) Any officer or employee of the State, or of any
7		county, who, in case of emergency, because of the
8		person's illness, or the person's incapacity caused by
9		accident while at work, or because of the illness of a
10		member of the person's immediate family including a
11		reciprocal beneficiary while the person is at work, is
12		conveyed in a motor vehicle to the person's place of
13		abode, or to a hospital or other place, but every such
14		use of such a motor vehicle shall be certified to by
15		the officer or by the head of the department,
16		commission, board, bureau, agency, or instrumentality
17		controlling or possessing the motor vehicle
18		immediately thereafter, and the certificate shall be
19		forthwith filed with the comptroller, in the case of
20		the State, or with the budget director, in the case of
21		a county; and
