SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT NIU, HONOLULU, OAHU, FOR THE USE, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, REPLACEMENT, AND REMOVAL OF AN EXISTING CONCRETE PAD, LADDER, STEPS, AND ROCK WALLS AND FOR THE USE, MAINTENANCE, REPAIR, REPLACEMENT, AND REMOVAL OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON.

WHEREAS, an existing concrete pad, ladder, steps, and rock walls were placed on state submerged lands fronting the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 3-7-002: seaward of 045, Niu, Honolulu, Oahu; and

WHEREAS, around 2013, the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) worked with the owners, Thomas and Sandra Young, to resolve the encroachments; and

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2013, the Department's Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands determined that the concrete pad, ladder, steps, and rock walls were not conservation district violations, and the Office had no objection to the issuance of an easement to resolve the encroachments; and

WHEREAS, on February 14, 2014, under agenda item D-15, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved a grant of a fifty-five year non-exclusive easement to resolve the encroachments; and

WHEREAS, section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution for this disposition of state submerged lands; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2014, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of Land and
