JUSTIFICATION:

Around 2012, the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) worked with the owners, David Knox and Beverly Hoversland, to resolve the encroachments of a landscaping area, concrete wall, and footing on state submerged lands fronting the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 4-7-019: seaward of 078, Kahaluu, Koolaupoko, Oahu.

On July 23, 2012, the Department's Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands determined that the encroachments predated the establishment of the Conservation District established in 1964 and supported the issuance of an easement to resolve the encroachments.

At its meeting of December 14, 2012, under agenda item D-14, the Board approved a grant of a 55-year non-exclusive easement to resolve the encroachments.
