SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF TWO (2) TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENTS COVERING PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT MOKULEIA, WAIALUA, OAHU, FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF THE EXISTING SEAWALL AND ROCK PILE, AND FOR USE, MAINTENANCE, AND REPAIR OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON.

WHEREAS, the existing seawall and rock piles were placed on state submerged lands fronting the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 6-8-010: seaward of 014 and 015, Mokuleia, Waialua, Oahu; and

WHEREAS, around 2013, the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) worked with the owner, Sutton Family Partners, to resolve the encroachments; and

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2013, the Department's Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands indicated its support to the issuance of two easements to resolve the encroachments; and

WHEREAS, on May 24, 2013, under agenda item D-12, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved grants of two (2) 55-year non-exclusive easements to resolve the encroachments; and

WHEREAS, section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution for this disposition of state submerged lands; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-seventh Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2014, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of Land and Natural Resources is hereby authorized to issue two (2) term, non-exclusive easements covering portions of state submerged lands fronting the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 6-8-010: seaward of 014 and 015, Mokuleia, Waialua, Oahu, for the maintenance and repair of the existing seawall and rock pile,

MEANS:

Concurrent resolution pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

JUSTIFICATION:

Around 2013, the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) worked with the owner, Sutton Family Partners, to resolve the encroachments of a seawall and rock pile on state submerged lands fronting the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 6-8-010: seaward of 014 and 015, Mokuleia, Waialua, Oahu.

On January 24, 2013, the Department's Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands indicated its support to the issuance of two (2) easements to resolve the encroachments.

At its meeting of May 24, 2013, under agenda item D-12, the Board approved grants of two (2) 55-year non-exclusive easements to resolve the encroachments.

Section 171-53, HRS, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior
