### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE LAND USE COMMISSION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that situations have
- 2 arisen before the land use commission that have called into
- 3 question certain commission members' conflicts of interest.
- 4 Under the state ethics code in chapter 84, Hawaii Revised
- 5 Statutes, certain state employees, officials, and legislators
- 6 are required to adhere to a standard of conduct when conducting
- 7 business for the State. As appointed state officials, land use
- 8 commission members are subject to the state ethics code.
- 9 However, existing land use commission rules that govern the
- 10 treatment of conflicts of interest do not sufficiently provide
- 11 proper guidance to handle certain situations.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to require the land use
- 13 commission to amend its rules clarify the process for
- 14 determining whether a conflict of interest exists.
- 15 SECTION 2. The land use commission shall amend its rules
- 16 pursuant to chapters 84 and 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
- 17 regarding its conflict of interest practices. The amended rules
- 18 pertaining to any parcel of land that is the subject of any

3	(1)	Clarify situations in which a commission member is
4		required to contact legal counsel to determine whether

9		or taking action; and
10	(3)	Establish a process that specifically states the steps
11		to determine whether a conflict of interest exists.
