<u>SB 2748</u> <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES. Consumers the bills of telecommunications carriers to contain only charges for products and services that are authorized by the consumer. Specifies prohibited "cramming" practices in phone bills. Requires public utilities commission to adopt additional rules to safeguard billings.		
<u>SB 2613</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO CONTRACTORS. Defines "incidental and supplemental work" for purposes of determining licensing requirements for general engineering and general building contractors.		CPN
<u>SB 2618</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE CONTRACTORS LICENSE BOARD. Increases the membership of the contractors license board from 13 to 15. Increases from 10 to 12 the members who are actively engaged in the contracting business. Increases from 5 to 7 the members who are specialty contractors. Requires that 1 member be affiliated with a state apprenticeship program. Decreases from 3 to 2 the members who are noncontractors.		CPN
<u>SB 2945</u> <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	Requires any contractor, po contractor, or	O CONTRACTORS. person applying for a license as an electrical ble and line contractor, high voltage electrical electronic systems contractor to possess a trade form electrical work in the State.	CPN
