preschool classrooms. Makes an appropriation.

RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING. EDU, WAM **SB 2975**

Makes an appropriation for the executive office on early learning Status & Testimony

to enter into contracts with third party providers for family child

interaction learning programs.

SB 2768 RELATING TO KINDERGARTEN. EDU, WAM

Makes kindergarten mandatory for a child who will be at least Status & Testimony five years of age on July 31 of the school year. Requires the

department of education, in collaboration with the executive office on early learning, to develop a statewide kindergarten readiness program. Establishes an individualized kindergarten readiness assessment system. Makes an appropriation to the

department of education.
