Ensures laws governing building contractors do not conflict with chapter 107, HRS. Appropriates funds to department of accounting and general

services for council's operating costs, including staff salaries.

Status & Requires the board of directors of the high technology development corporation to create a public safety technology park. Designates certain properties to be included in the park.
