## **DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):**

SB2764 RELATING TO STATE ENTERPRISE ZONES. EGH/ENE, WAM

Status and Testimony Expands eligible business activity in the state enterprise zones to

include the development of various types of renewable energy by sustainable business corporations, as defined in section 420D-2,

Hawaii Revised Statutes.

SB2703 RELATING TO SEAWATER AIR CONDITIONING. EGH/ENE, WAM

Status and Testimony Enables the production of air conditioning in an area or district

from a seawater air conditioning cooling system to benefit as an "eligible business activity" under the State's enterprise zones

program.

SB3027 RELATING TO ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. EGH/ENE, WAM

Status and Testimony Allows the energy resources coordinator and governor to

designate areas as energy zones. Provides a state business tax

credit to qualifying businesses in energy zones.
