DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):

SB2657 RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. ENE, CPN

Status and Testimony Transfers responsibility for the warranty of the area of a roof on

which a solar energy device has been installed from the roofing contractor to the solar contractor that installs the solar energy

device.

SB2652 RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY. ENE, CPN

Status and Testimony Establishes association rules for the placement of solar energy

devices in the absence of a private entity adopting rules. Makes permanent the prohibition on requiring an encumbrance on title for

the replacement of any solar energy device.

SB2178 RELATING TO ENERGY. ENE, CPN

Status and Testimony Permits the installation of clotheslines in any residential dwelling or

townhouse. Defines a reasonable restriction on the placement and use of clotheslines as any restriction that is necessary to protect public health and safety, buildings from damage, historic or aesthetic values, and shorelines under certain circumstances.

No testimony will be accepted.
