<u>HB 2318</u> (HSCR154-14) Status	RELATING TO RECORDS FOR FORENSIC EXAMINATIONS. Amends the Hawaii Penal Code with respect to forensic evaluations of defendants when there is a concern about fitness to proceed or penal responsibility, to require public agencies to provide records bout the defendants to the Judiciary, irrespective of confidentiality laws. HB 2572 Status	RELATING TO MOVIE THEATERS. Requires motion picture theaters open to the general public to provide closed captioning and descriptive narration of each motion picture being shown.	HLÌ, JUD
