RELATING TO ANIMAL CRUELTY. **JDL SB 2026** Prohibits the slaughtering or trafficking of dogs or cats for Status & human consumption. Testimony RELATING TO MEMBERS OF CONGRESS. **SB 2126 JDL** Provides that when a candidate other than the incumbent is Status & elected to Congress, and the incumbent vacates the office prior Testimony to the expiration of the incumbent's term, the Governor must appoint the member-elect to immediately fill the vacancy.
