<u>SB 2259</u> <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING. Prohibits parties in arbitration from including in their final positions any proposals that were not previously submitted in writing before impasse and about which an impasse in collective bargaining has not been reached. Authorizes the arbitration panel to decide whether final positions comply with all requirements and which proposals may be considered for inclusion in the final agreement.	JDL, WAM
<u>SB 2939</u> <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT PRACTICES. Repeals the condition that employers have a collective bargaining agreement with their employees in order for section 378-32(b), HRS, to apply.	JDL, WAM
<u>SB 1038</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM. Amends chapter 88, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to preserve the tax-qualified status of the Employees' Retirement System and to clarify the application of chapter 88 to civil unions.	JDL, WAM
SB 1038 Proposed SD1 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO THE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM. (Proposed SD 1) Requires the employees' retirement system to forfeit the employers' contribution and interest portion of retirement benefits upon a member's final conviction of or pleading guilty or nolo contendere to a felony. Establishes that the forfeiture of retirement benefits does not include a member's contributions to the system or vested retirement benefits. Applies forfeiture of benefits to members who leave active employment if the conviction or plea includes bribery, corruption, forgery, perjury, or any other crime related to the duties of the member's employment. Establishes procedure for the forfeiture of retirement benefits.	JDL, WAM
