<u>SB 2310</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO VICTIMS' RIGHTS. Requires the Department of Public Safety to give notice of the escape of a prisoner who is a domestic violence offender to each victim of the domestic violence and individuals protected by a restraining order against the escapee, immediately following the escape by the most reasonable and expedient means available.
