<u>SB 2303</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO FIREWORKS PERMIT FEES. Increases fireworks display permit fee from \$110 to \$300.	PSM, WAM
<u>SB 2302</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO FIREWORKS. Adds definitions and requirements for permanent and temporary consumer fireworks storage facilities. Clarifies fireworks prohibitions and exceptions to those fireworks prohibitions.	PSM, CPN
