HB 2070 Status	RELATING TO WATERSHED PROTECTION. Establishes a watershed initiatives program in DLNR. Subjects program employees to the civil service laws. Appropriates funds for FY 2014-2015.	WAL, FIN
<u>HB 2204</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO STORMWATER MANAGEMENT. Authorizes any county to establish and charge user fees to maintain stormwater management systems and infrastructure. Directs the Commission on Water Resource Management to report to the legislature on reducing stormwater runoff quantity and incentivizing stormwater reclamation and reuse.	WAL, FIN
<u>HB 1688</u> <u>Status</u>	RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS. Grants certain lessees of public land the right of first refusal to extend or renew a lease prior to a public auction of the land. Establishes appraisal process to assist in the determination of the fair market value of the land for rental purposes where the lease is renewed or extended. Provides for the disposition of improvements to the land where the lease is not renewed or extended.	WAL, FIN
