RELATING TO HEALTH COVERAGE FOR BRAIN INJURIES.

HTH/CPN, WAM

(SSCR359)

Status & Testimony

Requires certain insurance contracts and plans to provide coverage beginning 1/1/2014 for treatment of brain injuries, including cognitive and neurocognitive therapy, neurobehavioral and neuropsychological testing or treatment, and necessary post-acute transition services or community reintegration activities for a period of at least twenty years from the date the injury occurred and up to a lifetime cap per person of \$300,000.

Takes effect 7/1/2050. (SD1)
