Extends from July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2017, the Health Care Transformation Program, which is temporarily placed within the Office of the Governor, and effective July 1, 2017, transfers the Health Care Transformation Program to the Hawaii Health Care Planning and Policy Authority. Appropriates

HB 2597, HD2 RELATING TO TEACHERS.

(SSCR2970) Authorizes under the teacher national board certification incentive program an additional per year bonus for teachers who maintain current national board certification and teach at a

maintain current national board certification and teach at a school in a focus, priority, or superintendent's zone. Deletes obsolete references. Effective July 1, 2030. (HB2597 HD2)
